

### Dolly Washing

Use flannels, sponges and toothbrushes to wash the dollies with your children this will help with building their imagination and understanding routines.



### Pouring and Filling

Use pots, pans, bottles, jugs, containers to fill up and pour water. Talk about the sounds and actions of the water to introduce new words to your child.



### Food Dye

Use food dye in water to explore and introduce colour changes/mixing with your children. Add paper to your mixture to make some interesting affects!



## Water Play Ideas

### Car Wash

Use sponges, cloths and bubbles to set up a car wash where your children can wash the cars and build their imagination!
